

VOTE NO ON MEASURE I

DON'T RAISE OUR SALES TAX

- **Measure I doesn't solve Windsor's financial problems.**

It simply shifts the cost onto residents through a permanent sales tax that falls hardest on those who can least afford it.

- **Windsor's problem isn't a lack of revenue — it's a spending problem.**

Town revenues have generally kept pace with the cost of living, while expenditures, including employee compensation, have grown far more rapidly.

- **Measure I lacks meaningful taxpayer protections.**

The tax has no sunset date, no legal requirement that the money be spent on specific priorities, and it relies on promises of oversight that the Council could have provided years ago.

- **Accountability should come before higher taxes.**

Before asking residents to pay more, the Town Council should demonstrate a consistent commitment to transparency, independent oversight, reduction of top heavy management, and responsible budgeting.

- **A permanent sales tax is the wrong solution.**

Measure I fails to address the underlying causes of Windsor's financial challenges while placing a disproportionate burden on low and moderate income families, seniors, and other residents on fixed budgets.

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
