Nobody wants a new sales tax

- 1 This is a 1% general sales tax — about \$22.5 million a year,
- 2 Spending promises on the ballot are not a legal lock. Money will go to the general fund.
- 3 Audits check the books. They do not lock spending to campaign promises.
- 4 The oversight committee can advise. It does not control the checkbook.
- 5 Voters already said no: *Measure A in 2022 (county) and Measure D in 2024 (Yuba City).*
- 6 A general tax can be spent on salaries, pensions, benefits — or anything else the Board approves.
- 7 A new tax does not fix the budget problems that keep bringing this measure back.

No sunset. No spending lock. Vote NO.
