Council Comments

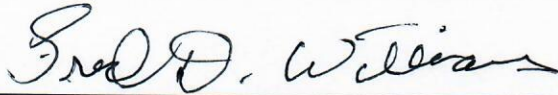
Councilmember Warford spoke about the car chase he had witnessed.
