Meeting Minutes

Councilmember Joe Soeder made a motion to approve the February 9, 2026 regular meeting minutes. Councilmember Warford seconded the motion. Councilmember Mitchell abstained from voting. Motion carried 5-0.

Financial Report February 2026

Councilmember Skinner made a motion to approve the financial report. Councilmember Whitehouse seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Police Department – February 2026

Chief Kistner presented the police report and answered all questions. He spoke briefly about the arrest of 2 juveniles attempting to steal a car and also spoke about the upcoming Cops, Community, and Coffee event on Saturday, March 14th.

Community Club

The Just Piggin Out Food truck will be at city hall on Monday, March 16th from 5-8pm.

Resident Taylor Avery was in attendance to present her idea for the Cornerstone Market, a farmers market that would start in April and tentatively run through the end of October. She asked to use the field at city hall. Councilmember Warford made a motion to allow, seconded by Councilmember Joe Soeder. Motion carried 6-0.

Councilmember Warford spoke about the upcoming Easter Egg Hunt on March 28th at 1pm and has scheduled the Balloon Lady.

Unfinished Business

Fischer Home Update

There was no Fischer Homes update.

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Mayor Williams provided an update on the patio homes. The city attorney is working on the annexation and will wait until a decision is made on a potential second piece of property before finalizing.

Resident Nate Curran gave an update on My Little Library.

Mayor Williams gave an update on landscaping and stated that the city would purchase artificial flowers for the city entrance flower beds.

Mayor Williams updated the Council on the status of the sidewalk on Reality Trail. He stated that he had not heard from them and would call them. He also spoke about a second bid that he had received that was much higher than the original bid.

Mayor Williams spoke about the status of the road sealing in Phase I. He will call PSI Paving to get an estimated time frame as to when they will begin work.

New Business

Council member Joe Soeder made a motion to have the first reading of Ordinance 2026-01 to increase the salary of council members from \$200/month to \$320/month. Motion carried 6-0. Councilmember Warford read the ordinance.

Resident Comments

Resident Nathan Russell complimented the Chief and Mayor. Resident Alex Kleinhenz inquired as to whether there was going to be a car show at the city picnic again this year and recognized Resident Nate Curran for helping the City by picking up garbage.

Council Comments

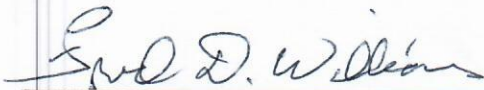
There were no council comments.

Mayor Comments

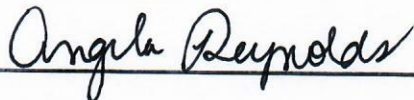
